Sylvania Progress Update – First Production from Steelpoort

The Directors of Sylvania are pleased to announce that wet commissioning of the integrated PGM and chromite recovery plant at Steelpoort has been completed and the plant is now in production, ramping up to design capacity.

Slurry was first fed into the chromite recovery section of the plant on Saturday 11 August 2007 whilst first operations of the PGM recovery section commenced on Sunday 26 August 2007. The entire plant is now running well, on a feed of current arisings tailings from the Samancor Steelpoort Chrome Plant, and is producing both chromite and PGM concentrate.

Facilities for Sylvania's hydraulic mining of old tailings dumps at Steelpoort are presently being commissioned and operations are expected to commence within the next few days. Further updates on production achievements will be forthcoming in due course. Sylvania now has two operational PGM flotation plants as well as a 25% share in the CTRP facility which is managed by Aquarius Platinum Limited.
